Business Plan - Public Consultation

BPC would like to thank all parishioners who took time to respond to the recent public consultation and comment on the draft Business Plan 2020 - 2023

Traffic Calming Red Lion Hill / Stamps Hill
Gina Small, SHDC Urban Fringe Team and
Darren Davey from Devon County Council (DCC)
attended the February meeting of BPC to
discuss possible traffic calming measures. S106
funding from the Sherford development is
available for this project. DCC is completing a
topographical survey of the area to inform its
proposals to BPC which will then be subject of
public consultation.

Community Speedwatch

Due to current restrictions and vulnerability of members Community Speedwatch has been suspended at present.

Defibrillator training

Due to COVID 19 defibrillator training has been postponed.

River Yealm Water Quality Working Group BPC has set up a group working with Wembury PC, Newton & Noss PC and Yealmpton PC, along with other interested parties to work with Environment Agency and South West Water to look at the quality of water in the River Yealm particularly relating to the discharge of sewage into the river at times of heavy rainfall.

BPC Climate Change Emergency Planning and Environment Group
