Welcome to the December news bulletin from Brixton Parish Council (BPC).

BPC are following guidance from Devon Association of Local Councils (DALC) and National Association of Local Councils (NALC) and continue to hold council meetings remotely and will do so for the foreseeable future. The meetings do follow the same format as the face to face meetings including the open forum, where all are welcome to join and discuss anything with councillors.

All meetings will be via Zoom with the details to join made available on the website and on the agenda for the meeting.

Local Council Award Scheme

BPC is striving to achieve the coveted Local Council Award Scheme Quality Gold Award and have been working on a business plan which will be subject to a period of consultation. Look for the Business Plan Consultation in the new year.

Parking / Traffic Calming

Following on from the initial meeting regarding parking around The Green and traffic calming on Red Lion Hill / Stamps Hill, BPC employed a consultant to look at these locations.

Look out for the consultation coming soon.

Community Speedwatch

Due to current restrictions and vulnerability of members Community Speedwatch has been suspended at present.

Defibrillator training

Due to COVID 19 defibrillator training has been postponed until at least January 2021.

New 'Super-Recycler Service

The new Super-Recycler Service will be introduced in two stages

Stage 1 – October 2020 Collection Day changes; Stage 2 – March 2021 launch of the Super Recycler Service.

Over the winter SHDC will send communications to all households about the new Super Recycler Service.

Delivery of new recycling containers to all households will start January 2021 ready for the new service in March.

Officers from SHDC will look at properties which will struggle to store the equipment and leave waste out for collection.

As there will be a kerbside collection of glass SHDC will monitor the usage of bottle banks over the next 12 months.

PCSO Potter update

PCSO Andy Potter has retired.

BPC would like to express its thanks to the work and dedication of PCSO Potter over the years. The PCSO role within Brixton will not be replaced and any issues will need to be directed to 999 or 101, or alternatively visit the website to log the details.
