The purpose of a Parish Plan is to set out the vision for our future. It is about setting down the aspirations and concerns of people and communities living within Brixton Parish and identifying the action needed to tackle these. It is your chance to say what you think about the social, economic and environmental issues which affect you and how you would like to see the community and Parish improved over the next 5–10 years.

In October 2008 following a well attended meeting set up by Brixton Parish Council a steering group of interested local people was set up to produce a Parish Plan.

The process to draw up a Parish Plan for Brixton gives everyone a chance to say:

- What is good about Brixton?
- What would make it better?
- What action is required to deliver these improvements and who should be doing it?

It will also help local community organisations and the Parish Council:-

- Inform and lobby other organisations and Government bodies
- Aid funding applications for the projects you support
- Protect or develop certain areas or projects
- Make sure that your wishes are widely known particularly by South Hams District Council and Devon County Council
- Ensure that the Parish is able to respond to the sustainable needs of local people and the community.

To do this we need to know what you think and feel about where you live. An initial consultation was carried out in the Spring of 2009 to find out what local people thought the headline issues were affecting them, their families and the community now and in the future. The themes have been taken forward into this questionnaire. We appreciate that there are a lot of questions but by completing them all you will help plan and influence the future of the Parish.

Using the enclosed envelope your completed questionnaire can be left in Brixton at the Post Office, the Village Stores, The Foxhound, St. Mary's Church, Rogers Garage or the Co-op at Staddiscombe next to Carrollsland by Monday 8th February 2010.

If you wish to make other arrangements for the collection of your completed questionnaire please telephone the number on the front page.

This questionnaire is designed for up to six people in one household. If there are more than six people in your household, extra copies can be obtained from the telephone number on the front page. Please interpret any mention of Brixton as meaning the Parish of Brixton.

The questionnaire is anonymous. There is no need to identify yourself if you do not want to. Please try and answer all the questions if you can. Most of the questions can be answered by ticking boxes, although there is space on some questions to add comments. There is a space at the back of the questionnaire for general comments or to add things that you think may have been overlooked.

The main findings of the questionnaire will be published in the Brixton Magazine and all households in the Parish will receive a summary of the Parish Plan in early summer 2010.
