Steer Point Quarry Restoration – February 2021

Here is the update on the Steer Point Restoration for the period of 25 January to 22 February 2021.

- •The total number of HGV deliveries for the period was 261 into the site which represented 93% of the permitted number over that period so there has been some significant improvement on the delivery rate since our last reporting which is encouraging
- •The weekly average was 65 loads with the maximum number of permitted loads in any one week of 70 into the site achieved in only one week
- •4,437 tonnes of material was brought into the site during that period
- •There were no public complaints logged by Aardvark during the period
- •There were no incidents reported to Aardvark in the period
- •We had one unscheduled delivery and suitable warning was given to the driver and the haulier that all visits need to be pre-booked but this did not cause any incident or complaint so the drive did adhere to the haulage protocols in place

The pre-app has been submitted to DCC for their consideration for a variation in the HGV movements as discussed at the last PC meeting and we are awaiting a response.
