Aim

To assist parishioners of Brixton Parish during the continuing impact of the cost-of living by providing information and practical support, and to complement any existing support from within the parish and beyond.

Tasks

- i. To provide information to all households about advice and information available locally through a leaflet delivered to households.
- ii. To set up a Community Help Box with essential hygiene products and basic food tinned and dried.
- iii. To provide a warm hub on agreed days at 'The Foxhound'
- iv. To apply for funding to relevant bodies
- v. To report back regularly to the relevant groups on progress
- vi. To monitor and regularly review the progress and impact of i-iii above and make appropriate changes
- vii. To continue to apply for funding where/when relevant - all monies will be held by Brixton Parish Council and will be updated at the monthly Parish Council meetings
- viii. To review the whole project annually by the end of March to identify the need to continue or develop existing and /or new services
- ix. To liaise and coordinate with other local cost of living crisis initiatives.
