**TEMPORARY 30MPH SPEED LIMIT**

**NOTICE** is hereby given that Devon County Council has made the above titled order.

From **WEDNESDAY 3 APRIL 2024**  
for a maximum of 18 months

Anticipated Finish **WEDNESDAY 3 JULY 2024**

No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed greater than 30 miles per hour on the sections of Affected Roads when temporary traffic signing is in place.

Roads affected -  
**A379 ELBURTON ROAD, PLYMOUTH**

The alternative, signed, route for vehicles will be via - EXISTING SPEED OF ROAD 40MPH - PROPOSED SPEED RESTRICTION OF 30MPH SPEED RESTRICTION APPLIES TO BRIXTON ROAD STATION BRIDGE AND ITS APPROACHES.

This temporary restriction is considered necessary to enable -  
**WORKS REQUIRED TO IMPLEMENT EMERGENCY SPEED RESTRICTION FROM 40MPH DOWN TO 30MPH AS WELL AS NEW ROAD LAYOUT ON THE APPROACHES TO BRIXTON ROAD STATION BRIDGE.**
