On behalf of Brixton Parish Council, I am writing to welcome you to the Parish of Brixton in the South Hams District of Devon.

Brixton is a parish with a long history based on farming, with other rural and commercial activities centred around the river Yealm. The village of Brixton reflects its history with its 14th Century Church, Priests Cottages together with the Feoffee Trust cottages in Old Road and the Park. More recent housing, including Carrollsland, Chittleburn and Canes Orchard has shaped the character of the village and parish as demand for homes has grown. The area, below the A379 in Brixton village, is in the South Devon National Landscape (previously South Devon Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty). The growth of the new town of Sherford with plans for 5,500 homes, schools, shops, green spaces, and a country park (500 acres) and its developing communities is changing the identity of the parish. I hope that our long history and the modern development on the urban fringe of Plymouth will be of mutual benefit to all people who live in the parish.
